### **National Services Directory**

The programme board received an update in relation to the National Service Directory (NSD). The NSD will provide a single point of access to information and prioritised and quality assured health and wellbeing, across the Aberdeen City Health and Social Care Partnership. A project team has been developed to progress this work and further updates will be shared across the partnership in due course.

### **Practice WIFI**

The roll out of additional wireless access points to GP practices is nearly complete. A total of 107 additional points have been added. In total a further 34 access points were added over and above the 1 additional funded access point to allow full coverage for the Link Workers within practices. Not all points are active however this work will be completed in the next couple of weeks and a further communication will be circulated.

### **Workforce planning**

Work is developing with both Career Ready and Developing the Young Workforce to help the Partnership find its the workforce of the future.

Career Ready-is a 2-year programme which matches students to a mentor and includes a high-quality paid internship within the mentor's organisation. The IJB have agreed to fund 2 mentoring arrangements for 2018/20 and 2 volunteer mentors have been identified in the Partnership.

The Developing the Young Workforce (DYW) programme is a Scottish Government initiative which seeks to drive the creation of a world-class vocational education system and to reduce youth unemployment by 40% by 2021. The DYW group for the North East is based at the Aberdeen & Grampian Chamber of Commerce and is working closely with employers and secondary schools in Aberdeen. The IJB agreed to further develop the work that DYW are doing with the Partnership and Harlaw Academy and Hazlehead Academy.
