Through our case worker support role we will provide broad range of support including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Personal support – delivered by trusted professionals through a 1:1 case management approach</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Holistic support – identifying, assessing and overcoming wider barriers to employment, such as housing, health and finances. Supporting the young person to develop and grow their capacity for work</li> <li>■ Strong engagement and continuity of support to build trust and understanding of the individual’s needs</li>   <li>■ Genuine outcomes – Learning and development to meet the requirements of the world of work, including access to industry related and employability related qualifications, work tasters, flexible work placements and offering real and sustainable modern apprenticeships or jobs through our private and public sector employer partners; and access to further education and learning</li> <li>■ In work support – training and support for employer mentors, and ongoing learning and development in the work place for the young person. Ensuring the young person has opportunities to continue to grow their career and increase their earnings capacity</li> <li>■ Continuity of support – We provide additional and timely support to ensure young people stay on track to sustain their achievements and where required, participants are welcome to return to our programme</li> </ul>
